Extension of Deadline to file Appeals

Under the *Traffic Safety Act*, certain regulatory decisions and actions can be appealed to the Alberta Transportation Safety Board (ATSB). People wishing to commence an appeal have 30 days to file their appeal with the ATSB.

On April 9, 2020, the Minister of Transportation announced a [Ministerial Order](#) that **extends the appeal deadline** for decisions and actions made during the public health emergency.

Specifically, for decisions or actions that were made between

- the first day of the public health emergency (March 17, 2020) and
- the last day of the public health emergency (which is currently set to be June 15, 2020)

people wishing to appeal will have until July 15, 2020 to file their appeal with the ATSB.

If the public health emergency lasts longer or is ended before June 15, 2020, the filing deadline may be changed accordingly. Further updates will be provided.
